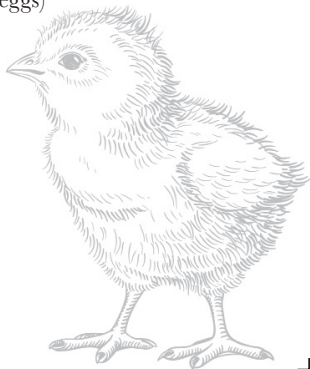

Barred Plymouth Rocks
